## DIRECTIONS

Unheated tap water should be used for dilution.

**General Cleaning:** Stainless steel, walls, countertops and ceramic tile floors: Dilute 16-24 ml of MULTIMAX per litre of cold tap water (2-3 oz/gal) (1:64-1:40).

**Auto scrubbing:** Dilute 4 ml of MULTIMAX per litre of cold tap water (0.5 oz/gal) (1:256).

**Heavy duty and machine cleaning:** Depending on degree of soiling, dilute 32-48 ml of MULTIMAX per litre of cold tap water (4-6 oz/gal) (1:32-1:21).

**FOR USE IN FOOD PLANTS:** All food should be removed or covered prior to use and food contact surfaces are to be thoroughly rinsed with potable water so there will be no contamination of food as a result of its use.

## STORAGE
