DIRECTIONS

Pour a little LIQUID DISH into running water to fill the basin or wash sink. Wash glasses and cups first followed by more soiled items. Grease, oils and food particles are removed to give clean, soil-free surfaces.

For hand-washing of dishes, crockery, cutlery, pots and pans: Use 1-2 oz of LIQUID DISH per gallon of water (8-16 ml/litre) (1:128-1:64).
